Information Regarding Pool Parties

Pool parties are held on at the following times:

Friday evenings from 5:30pm - 7:00pm

Saturdays from 11:30am -1:00pm or 1:30pm - 3:00pm

Sundays from 1pm - 2:30pm

The cost for a pool party is \$100.

This includes 90 Minutes of Pool time and 1 Hour of the Cafeteria.

Absolutely NO food or drink will be allowed in the pool area.

Adequate adult supervision is required for the pool party.

Lifeguards are not there to babysit children, they have a job to do.

All Pool Parties need prior approval from the Pool Coordinator and the Buildings and Grounds Department before they can be scheduled and approved. Please use the sign up on the pool website or go to www.calendly.com/hudsonhspool to select a date and time to have your party.

After submitting your request, the Pool Coordinator will reach out to you to confirm and provide any additional information. Your application will be sent to the School District for final approval. This process may take a couple of days.

Do not send out invitations until the pool party is approved by the school district and you receive a follow up call or email from the pool coordinator.

Checks may be made payable to Hudson City School District. Payment will be made to the lifeguard on duty at the party that day.

Any toys at the pool are open for use during the party as well as the diving board. You may also bring your own toys if you wish. Lifejackets and puddle jumpers are allowed at the pool as long as they are Coast Guard approved. Swimmies are <u>not</u> approved.

The Depth of the pool ranges from 3.5ft to 12ft

There <u>will</u> be lifeguards on duty for your pool party. Lifeguards have the right to kick out anyone who does not follow the rules or becomes disruptive

THERE IS NO SWIMMING IF A LIFEGUARD IS NOT ON DUTY
