What Is Band?

The Band program is a chance for students to learn brass, wind and percussion instruments. Students receive weekly lessons, attend band rehearsals, and perform in a variety of events throughout the year. Participating in the band program is a <u>commitment</u> made with the student and parent. Students are asked to practice each night in order to improve on their instruments. Band members should remain on their chosen instrument in order to progress. Please remind your child that this is a commitment for the ENTIRE year. Switches may not be granted.

When Do We Meet?

Each band student meets for a 37 minute lesson once a week. Lessons are held during the school day and rotate each week. Full band for grade 5 will meet every other day. Full band for grade 4 will meet once a week. **Students are required to make up missed work when they attend a lesson or reschedule a lesson if they are unable to attend.**

How Do I Get An Instrument?

Many families rent instruments through a music store. This guarantees their child the opportunity to be in band. Only a limited number of school instruments will be available this year. There will most likely be a waiting list for school instruments.

## What Other Materials Will I need?

- 1. A Folder or 3 ring binder to put their music in.
- 2. A Lesson Book (Accent on Achievement) for their instrument, usually costs around \$10-\$12.
- 3. A supply of pencils, highlighter
- 4. Supplies appropriate for their instrument.

<u>Clarinet, Saxophone</u>: Folder, Pencil, Book, Reeds (Appr. 4 to keep in case size 2 1/2),

(Cleaning Kit) Cork grease

<u>Trumpet</u>: Folder, Pencil, Book, Valve Oil, (Cleaning Kit)

Flute: Folder, Pencil, Book, (Cleaning kit)

<u>Trombone:</u> Folder, Pencil, Book, Slide Oil, (Cleaning Kit)
<u>French Horn:</u> Folder, Pencil, Book, Key Oil, (Cleaning Kit)
<u>Baritone:</u> Folder, Pencil, Book, Valve Oil, (Cleaning Kit)

Percussionists will need to buy their own sticks (size 5A). John Keal Music has a Bell

Kit rental that includes a pad, sticks and a bell set.
